**Format:** 90 minutes + 30 seconds per move from move one to the end of the game (Fischer).

**Default/Forfeit Time:** 30 minute forfeit time from start of each round.

**Half Point bye Policy:** Players can take a maximum of 2 ½ points in the first 7 rounds.  
A half point bye must be declared before the commencement of the previous round.

### Conditions of Entry:

- 1) All Players must be members of Chess Association of Qld
- 2) State Champions must have been 'bona fide' residents of Queensland for at least ninety days prior to the commencement of the tournament. Residency is not a requirement for participation in Queensland Championship
- 3) The current Queensland Junior Champion shall have right of entry and will receive free entry
- 4) The current Queensland Reserves Champion shall have right of entry and will receive free entry
- 5) Should a vacancy occur at the commencement of the event, the vacancy shall be filled by the highest-rated available reserve.
- 6) **Foreign players without a FIDE id number will not be accepted. Foreign players will need to obtain a FIDE id number from their National Federation and advise that number prior to their entry being accepted.**

**Australian Citizens & Permanent residents without FIDE id numbers will need to provide a date of birth prior to the start of the event or their entry will not be accepted.**
